All the abstracts must be submitted via "online submission system". All the abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific program committee and selected for the participation. All the required fields must be completely filled with relevant information. Any incorrect information will be dropped from the abstract evaluation.

Abstract must be sent in English language.

Abstract must not exceed 400 words and must be structured into Introduction, Material and methods, Results and Conclusion.

Confirmation of receipt of abstract will be sent via email.

Once the abstract is accepted by the committee, the presenter must register within the given time, otherwise the abstract will be dropped off from the process.
